Jan. 22-Feb. 7 On Golden Pond	Directed by Rachael Lindley	Ethel and Norman Thayer returning to their summer home on Golden Pond for the forty-eighth year. They are visited by their divorced, middle-aged daughter and her dentist fiancé, who then go off to Europe, leaving his teenage son behind for the summer. The boy quickly becomes the "grandchild" the elderly couple have longed for, and as Norman revels in taking his ward fishing and thrusting good books at him, he also learns some lessons about modern teenage awareness. In the end, as the summer wanes, so does their brief idyll, Norman and Ethel are brought even closer together by the incidence of a mild heart attack. Time, they know, is now against them, but the years have been good and, perhaps, another summer on Golden Pond still awaits.

And when fate throws a wrench into one of their lives, these friends, proving the enduring power of 'teamwork', rally 'round their own with the strength and love that takes this comedy in a poignant and surprising direction. <i>The Dixie Swim Club</i> is the story of these five unforgettable women - a hilarious and touching comedy about friendships that last forever.
